and peace on earth.

[light the next shortest BLUE candle]

Reader 1: And now we remember how the angels told the shepherds
news of great joy.

Reader 2: God's beloved was born among us, so that we could all
have joy deep in our hearts.

Reader 1: This joy is deeper than sorrow, stronger than fear.

This joy surprises us even on the coldest, darkest winter day.

Reader 2: We light a candle for joy. May joy shine bright in our hearts
and in every human heart.

[light PINK candle]

**All: God of deep joy, we do not always feel happy. Sometimes we
feel sad. Sometimes we are worried.**

**Sometimes we feel lonely. But your joy runs deeper than our
every sorrow. May it bubble up within us, so that we can bring
light and joy to all we meet. In the name of Jesus, Joy to the
world! Amen.**
